I teach art in the Anchorage School District at Polaris K-12 and joined the Anchorage Clay Arts Guild in 2020. Most of my work is made from local clay that I dig up. Several years ago I decided to see what it was good for, since there's so much of it. After a lot of trial and error and many experiments, I now find it hard to appreciate any clay more than what I get in my own backyard. There's something magnificent in the entire process from picking clay to knowing people use the pots. I can't quite describe it. Seems like it's because I like to play in the mud and play with fire, but feels like there's more to it.
